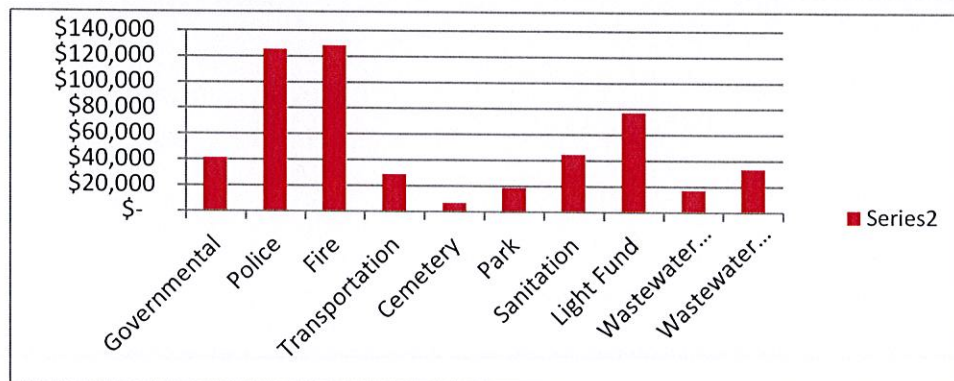

RESOLUTION**

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE GRANTING OF LOCAL INCENTIVES TO THE WEBSTAURANT STORE, INC., AND ANY SUBSEQUENT ASSIGNEES OR APPROVED AFFILIATES THEREOF

WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the City of Madisonville, Kentucky (the “Council”) finds that it is a legitimate public purpose of the City of Madisonville (the “City”) to undertake activities for the purpose of attracting and retaining jobs for residents of this community; and

WHEREAS, under the Kentucky Economic Development Incentive Program (the "Program") incentives are authorized for the purpose of encouraging the development and expansion of the service and technology industry in Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, the Program provides state incentives to businesses which locate or expand in the Commonwealth, including regional or national headquarters, thus creating and preserving jobs for Kentuckians; and

WHEREAS, the Program encourages local governments to participate in these incentives for businesses within their jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that offering the local incentives authorized by Program for the purpose of attracting and retaining businesses is in furtherance of the public purpose of Madisonville and will benefit the City by creating new sources of tax revenue for the support of the public services provided by the City; and

WHEREAS, The Webstaurant Store, Inc., has applied for the benefits authorized under the Kentucky Economic Development Incentive Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MADISONVILLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Council does hereby approve participating in the grant of incentives to The Webstaurant Store, Inc., (the “Company”), and any subsequent assignees and approved affiliates thereof, under the Program, subject to the Company satisfying the requirements set forth in the Program, including minimum full time jobs, investment, and wage and employee benefits, and subject to the terms of this Resolution.

Section 2: That the Council does hereby agree to participate in the grant of incentives under the Program by contributing 1% of the 1.5% local occupational tax with City of Madisonville participation continuing for a period of ten (10) years.

Section 3: That the Mayor and other appropriate officers and employees of the City of Madisonville are authorized and directed to execute, acknowledge and deliver on behalf of the City of Madisonville any and all papers, instruments, certificates, affidavits and other documents, and to do and cause to be done any and all acts and things necessary or proper for the grant of incentives as authorized

by the Program and this Resolution.

Section 4: This Resolution shall be effective upon its passage and approval.

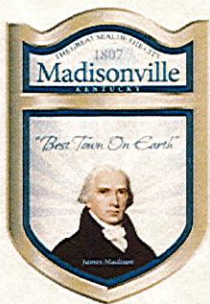
