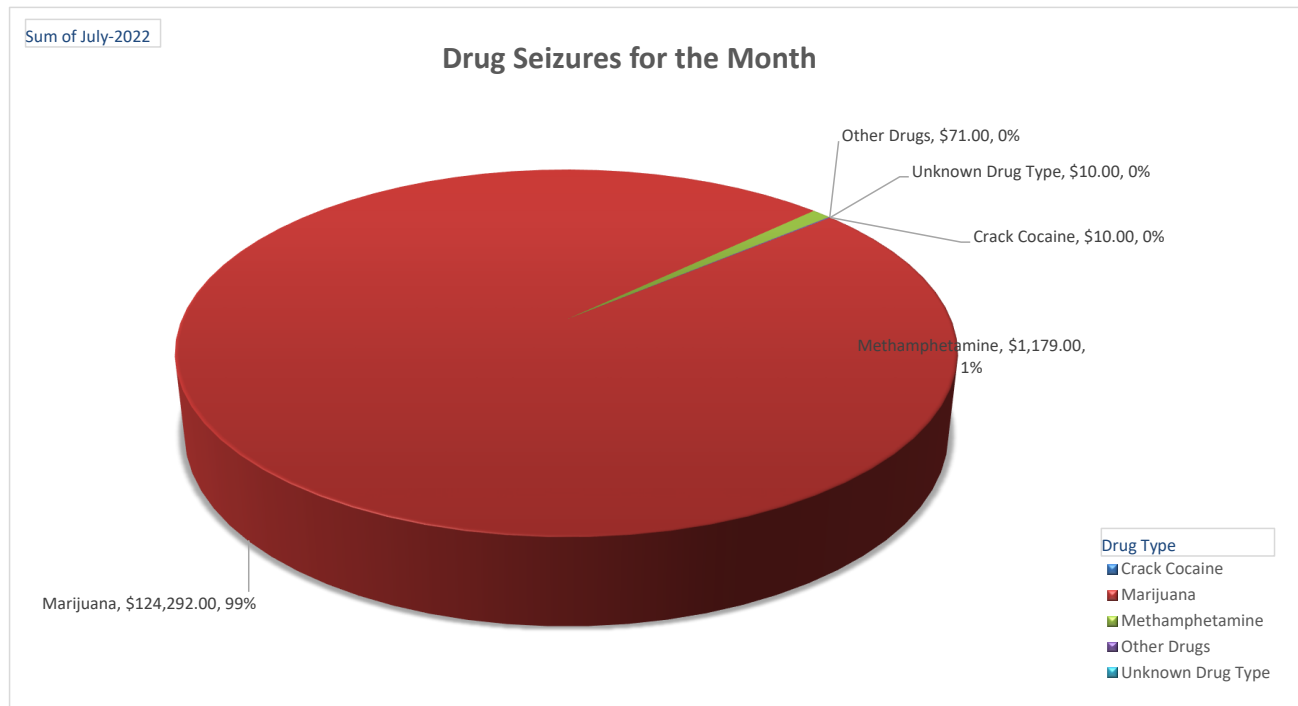

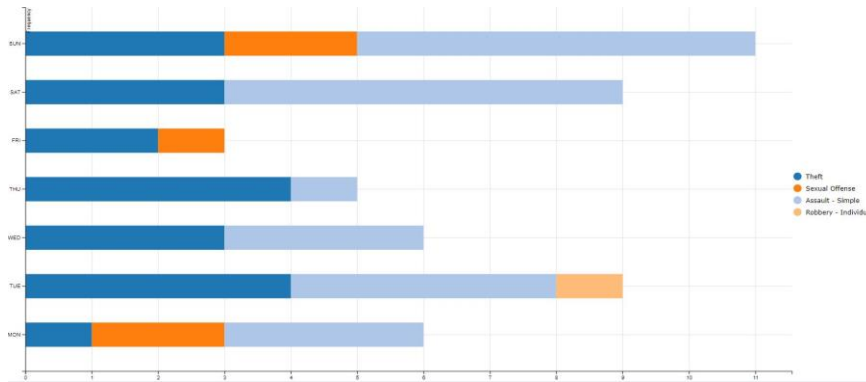

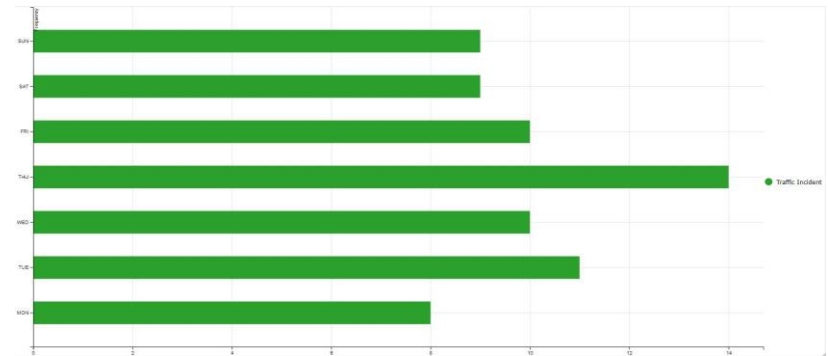

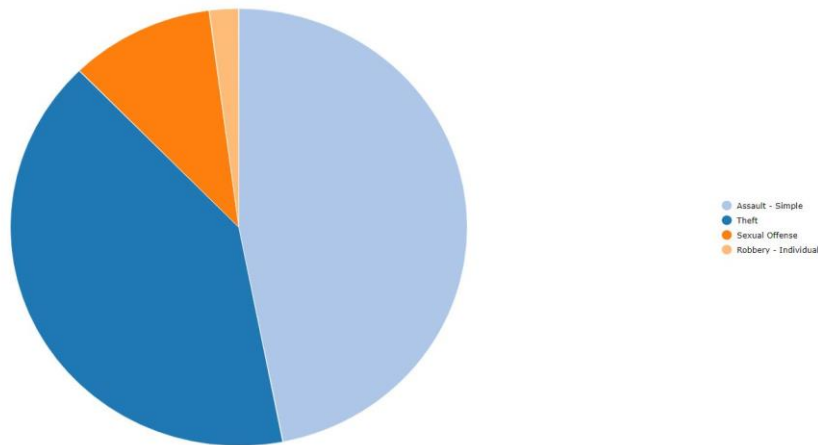
Part 1 Crimes by Day of Week



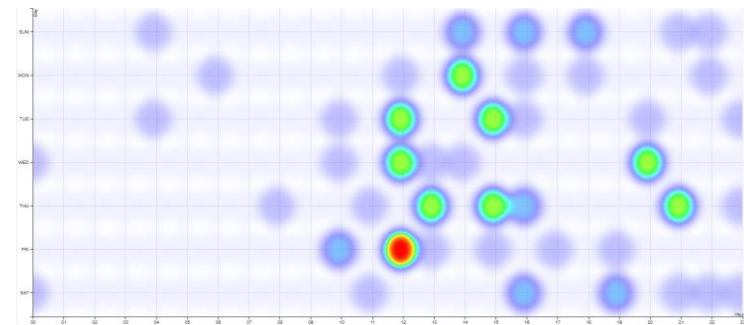
Traffic Accidents by Day of Week

Traffic Accident Highest Times

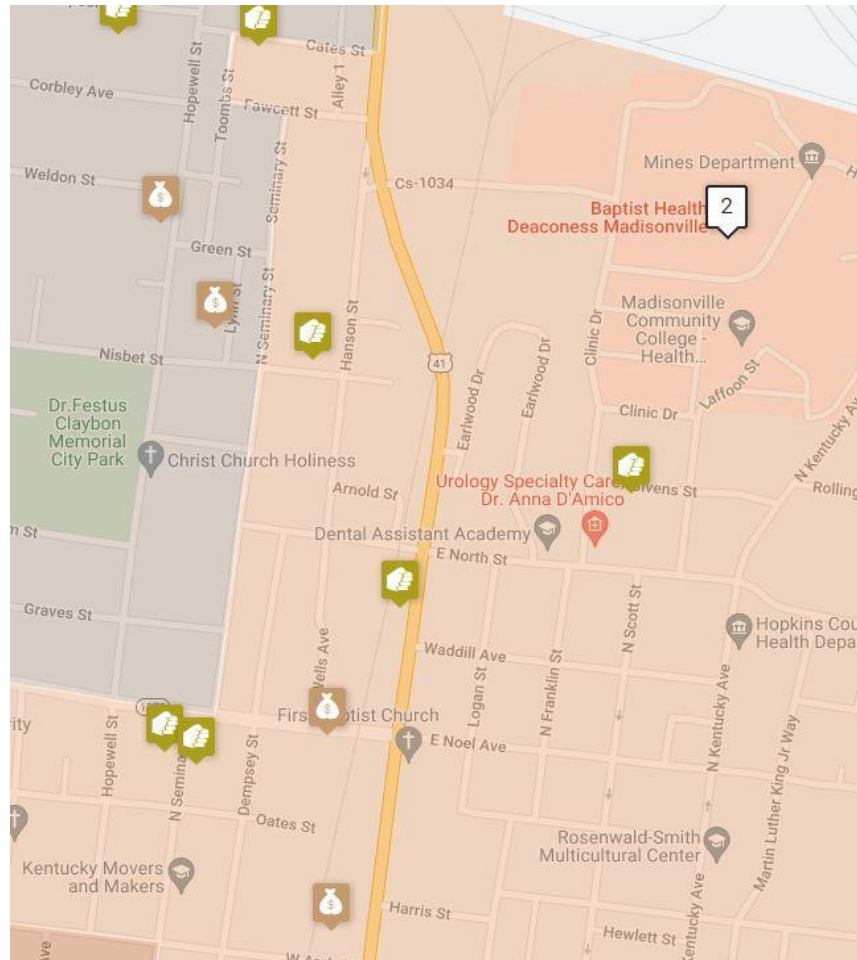

Part 1 Crimes Highest Density

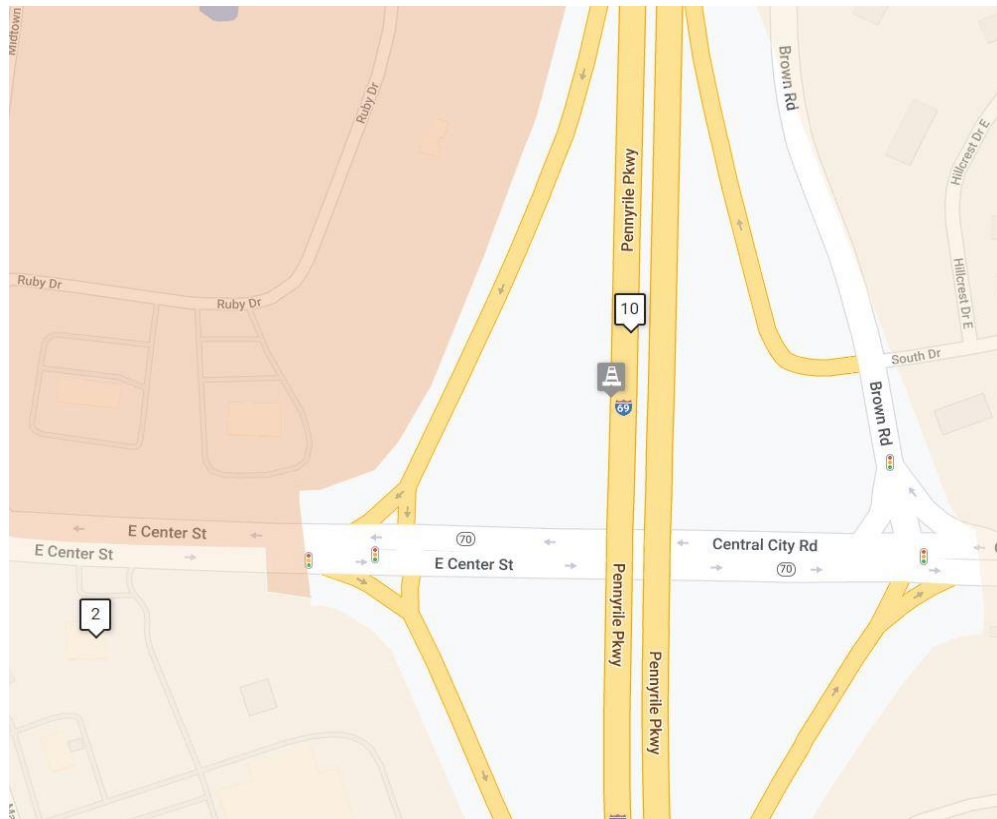

Traffic Accidents Highest Density





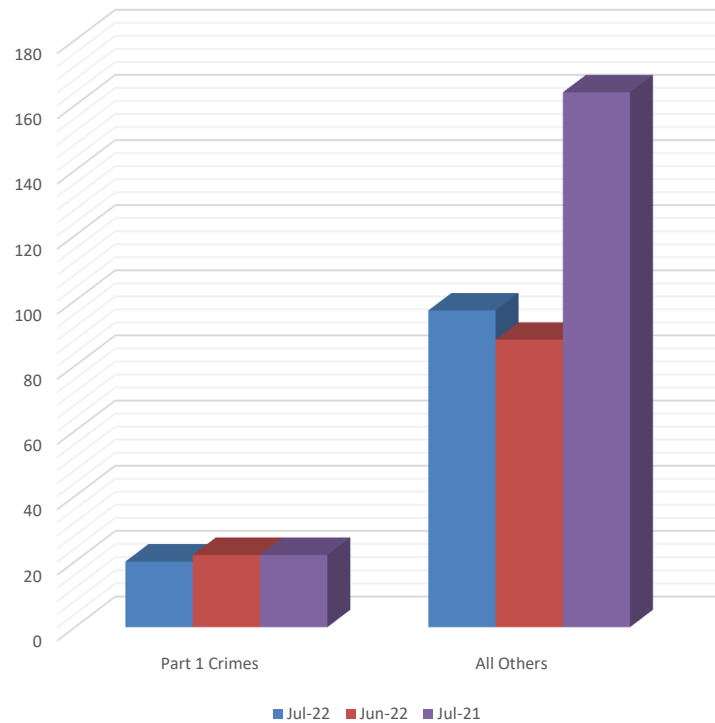

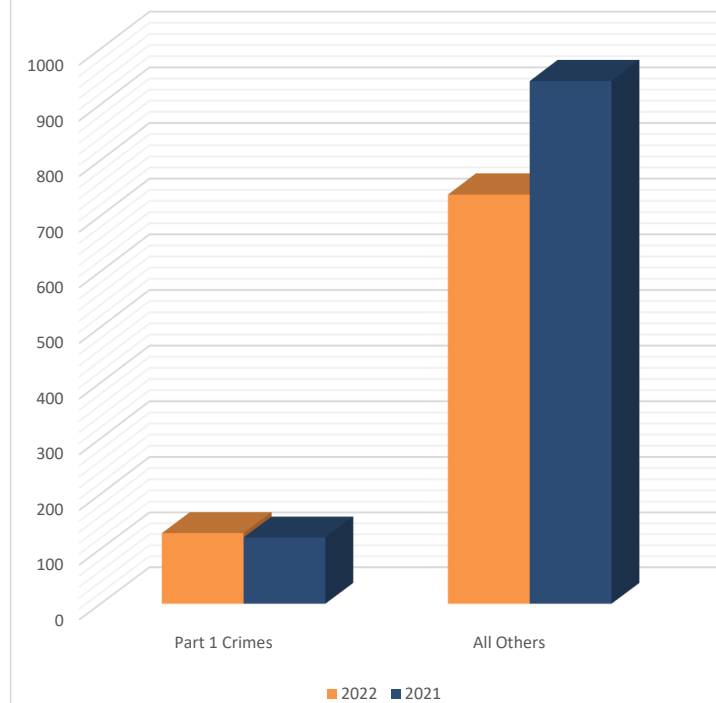

WITNESSETH: On August 27, 2010, a Complaint was filed by the City of Madisonville in Civil Action 10-CI-00949 styled "City of Madisonville, Kentucky v. Gloria Byford, requesting the Hopkins Circuit Court find that the property located at 454 Woodson Avenue, Madisonville, Kentucky, hereinafter described, was in violation of the City of Madisonville Code of Ordinances and constituted a public nuisance, representing an immediate danger to the health and wellbeing of the community; and

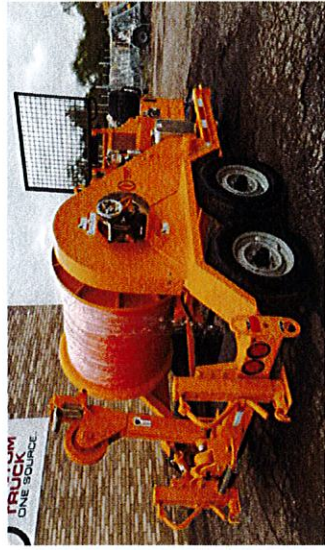
