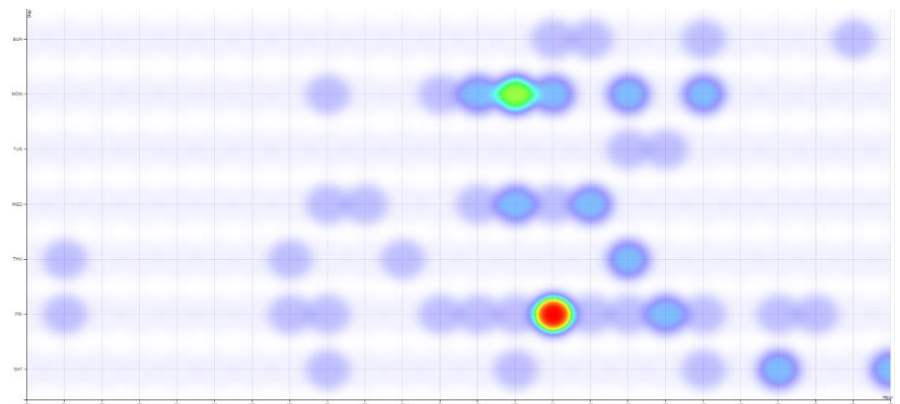
Traffic Accidents by Day of Week

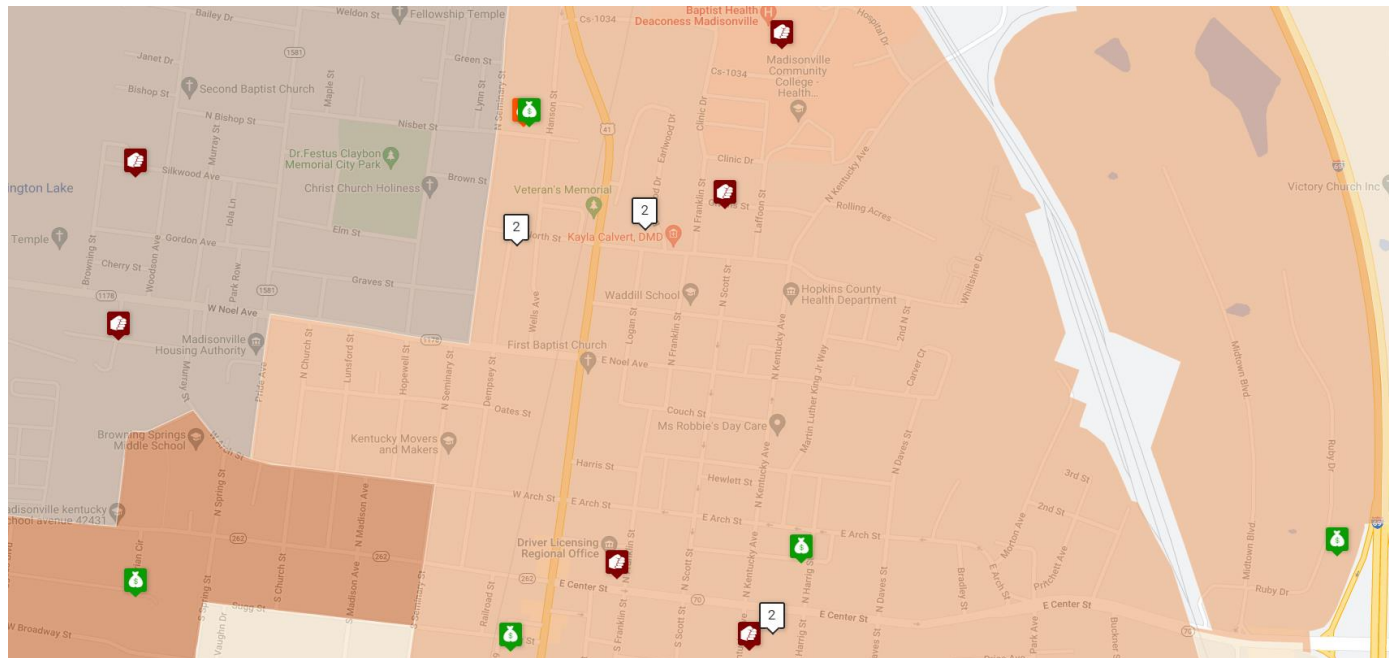

Part 1 Crimes Highest Density

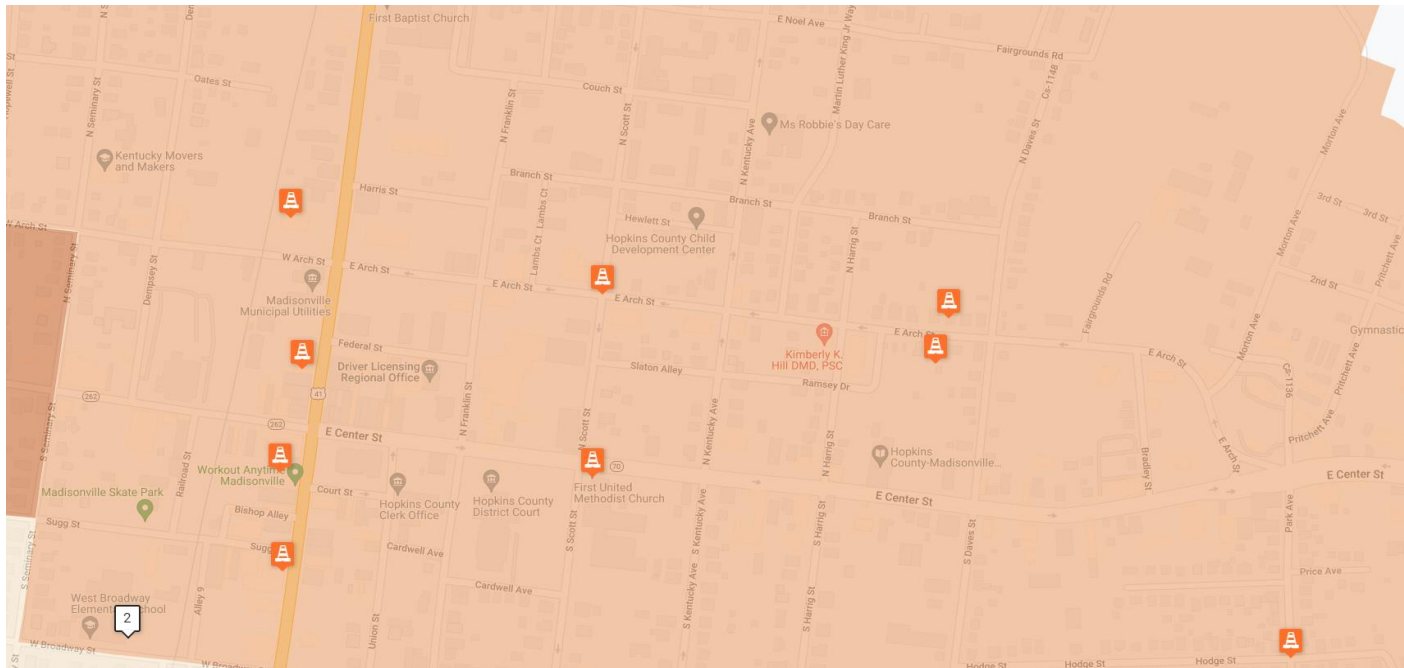

Traffic Accidents Highest Density





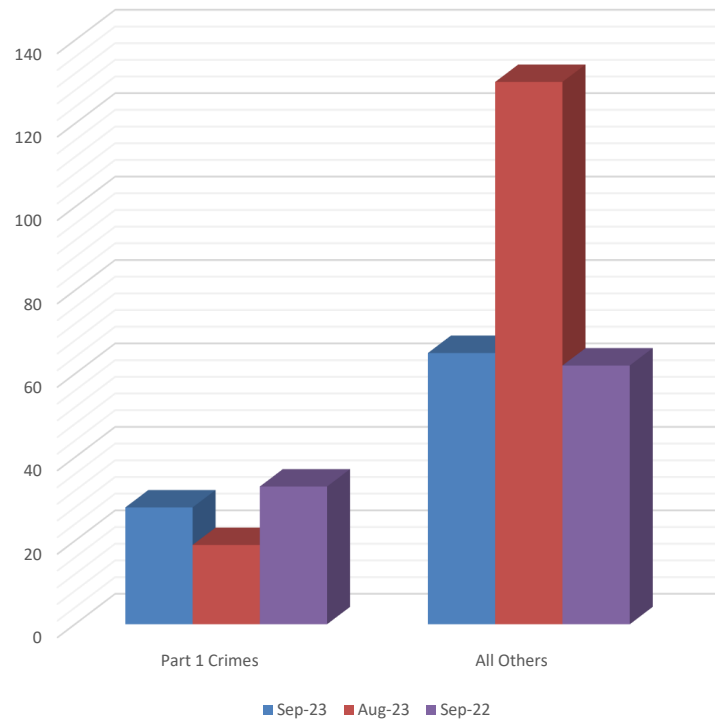

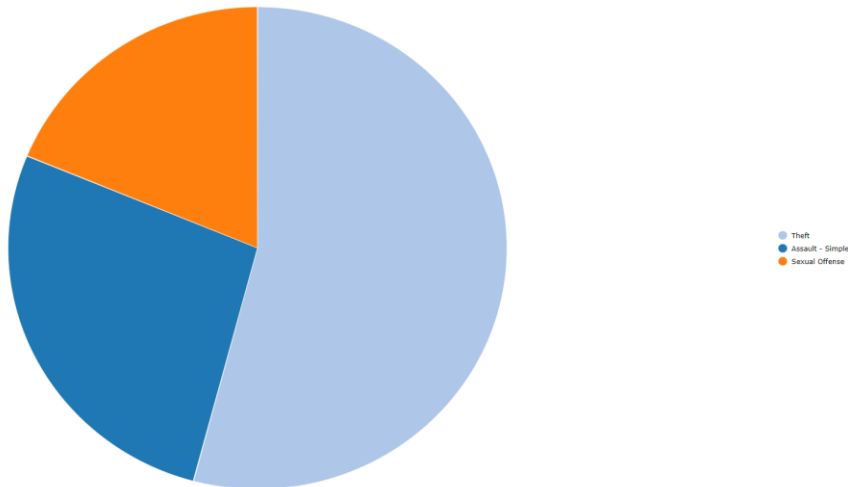
Part 1 Crimes by Day of Week



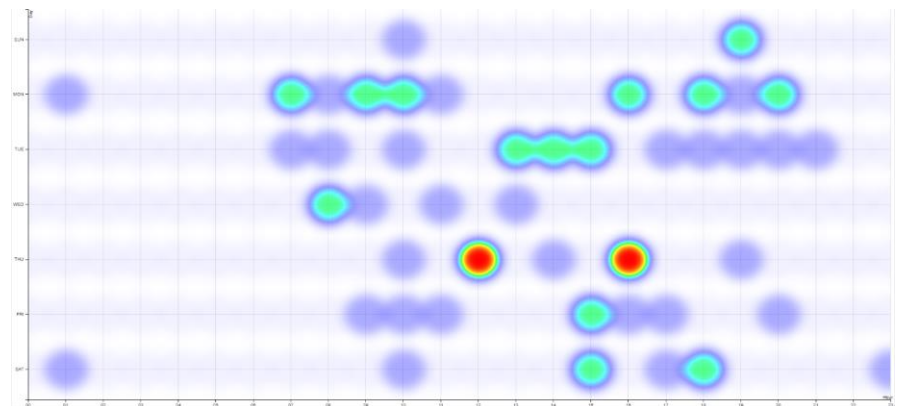
Traffic Accidents by Day of Week

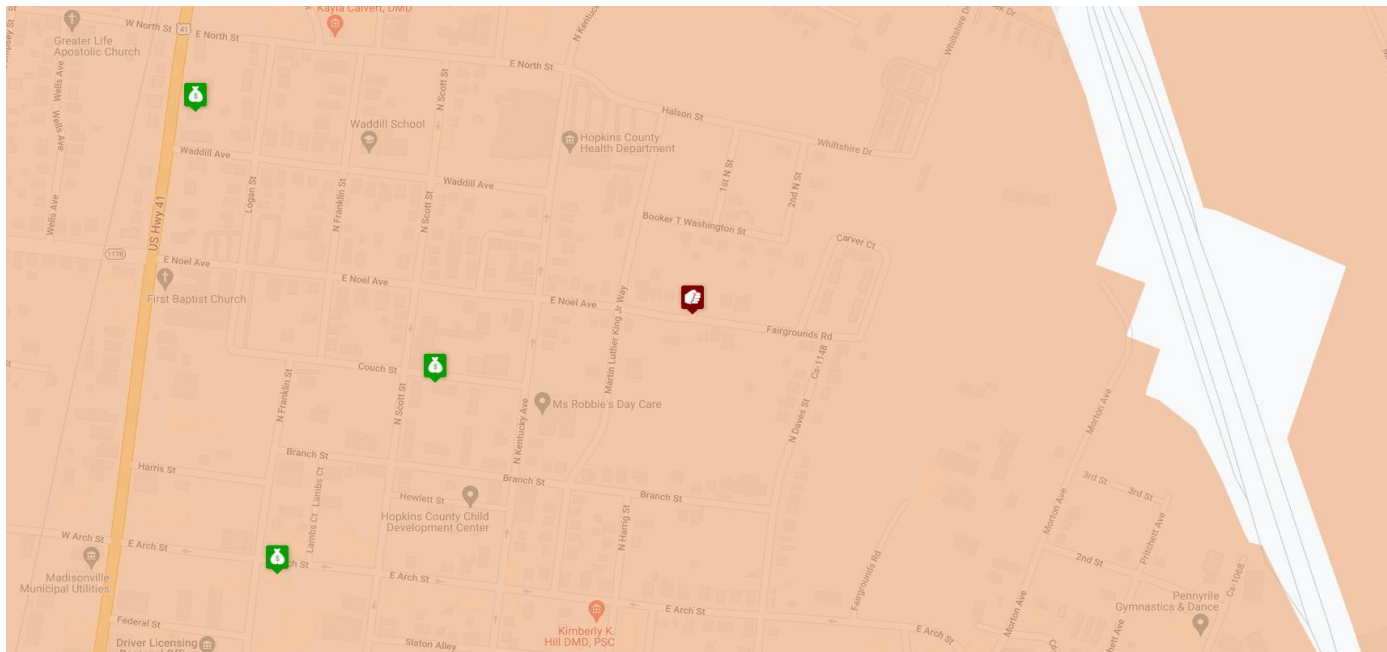

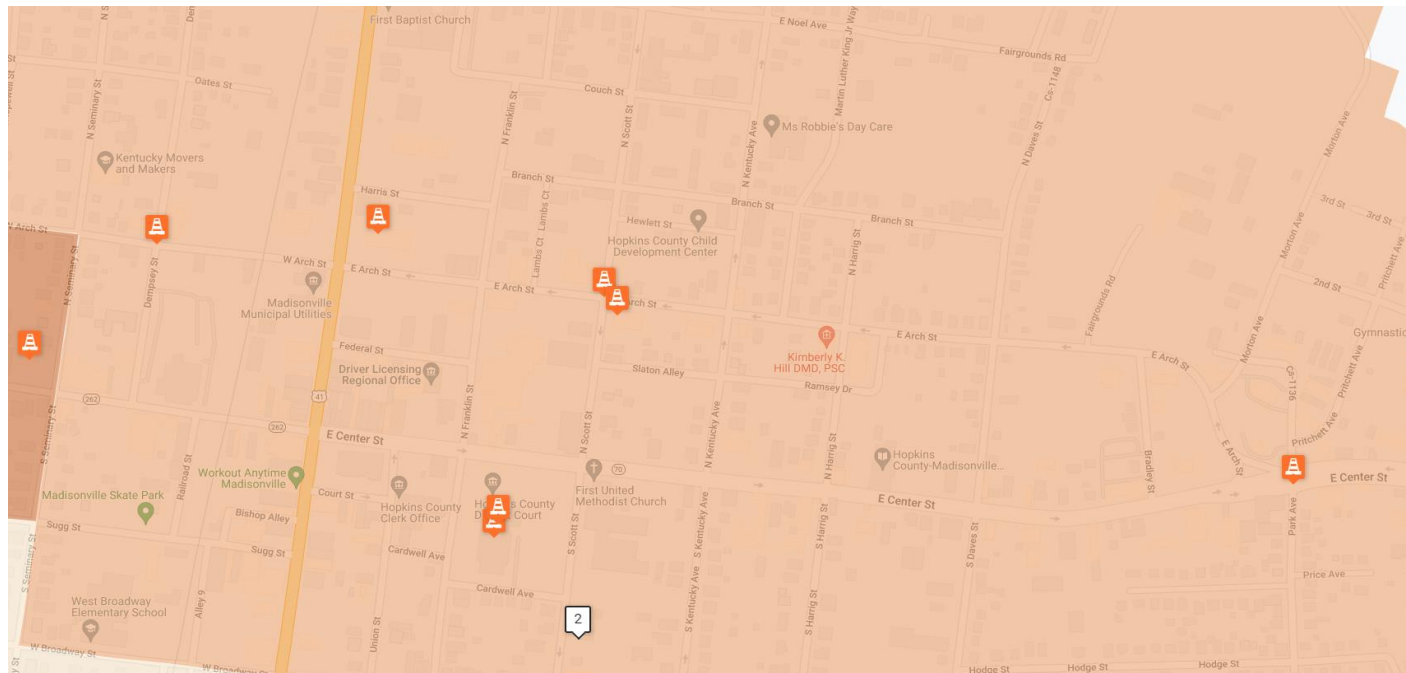


Part 1 Crimes Highest Density

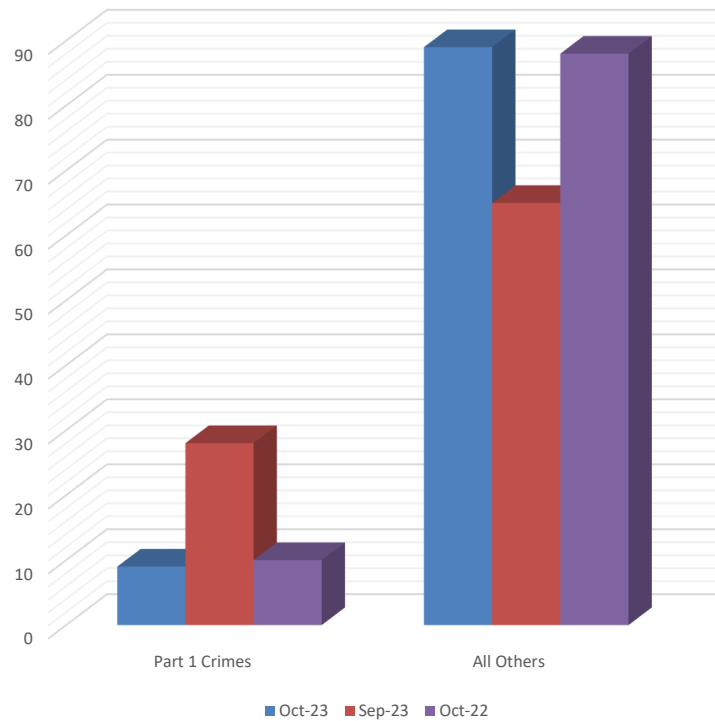
