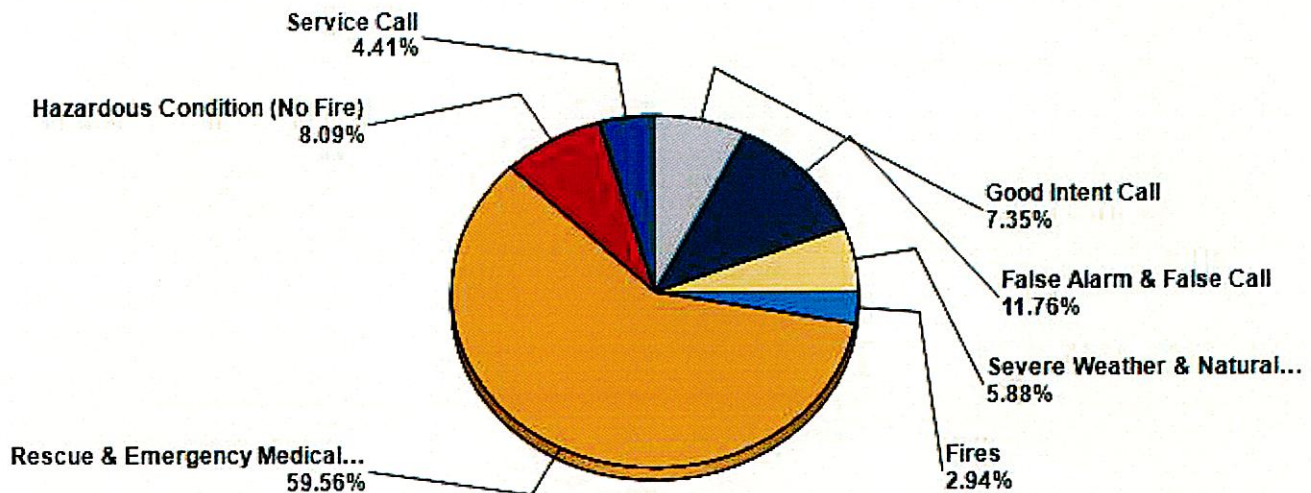

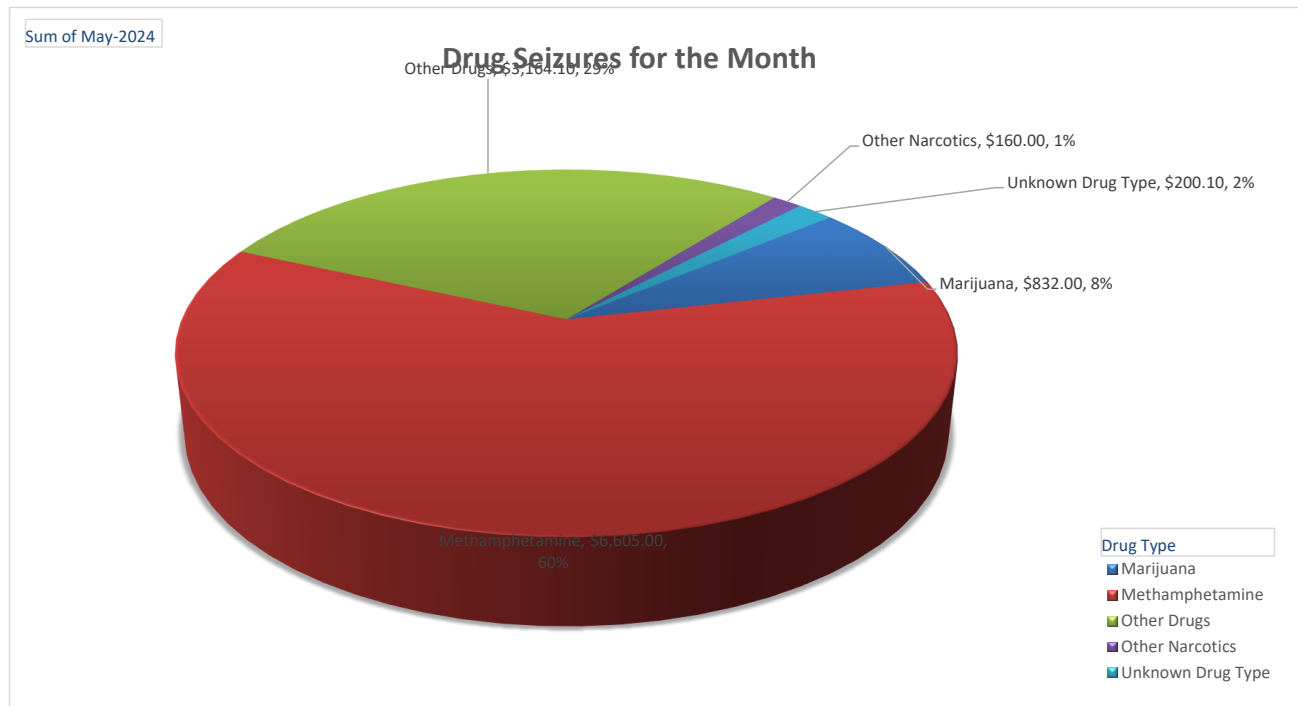

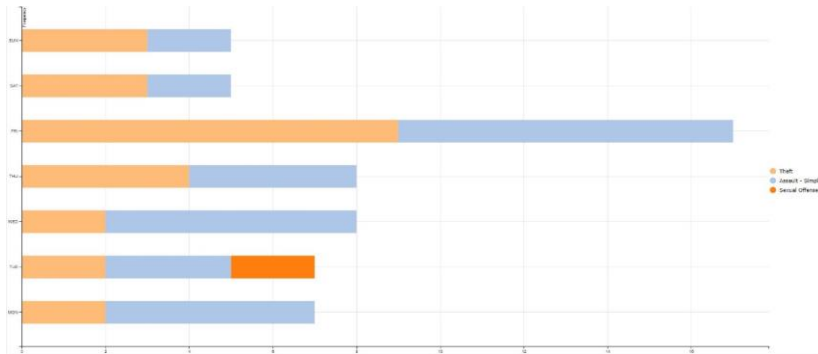

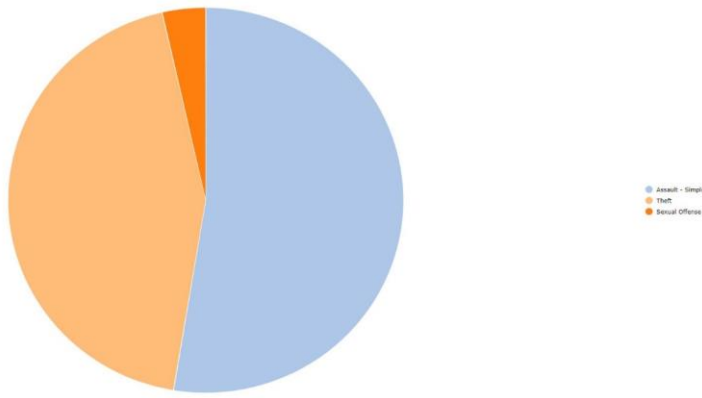
Part 1 Crimes by Day of Week



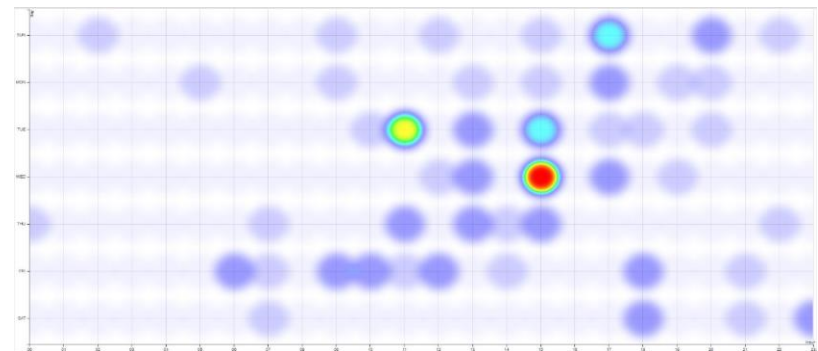
Traffic Accidents by Day of Week

Traffic Accident Highest Times

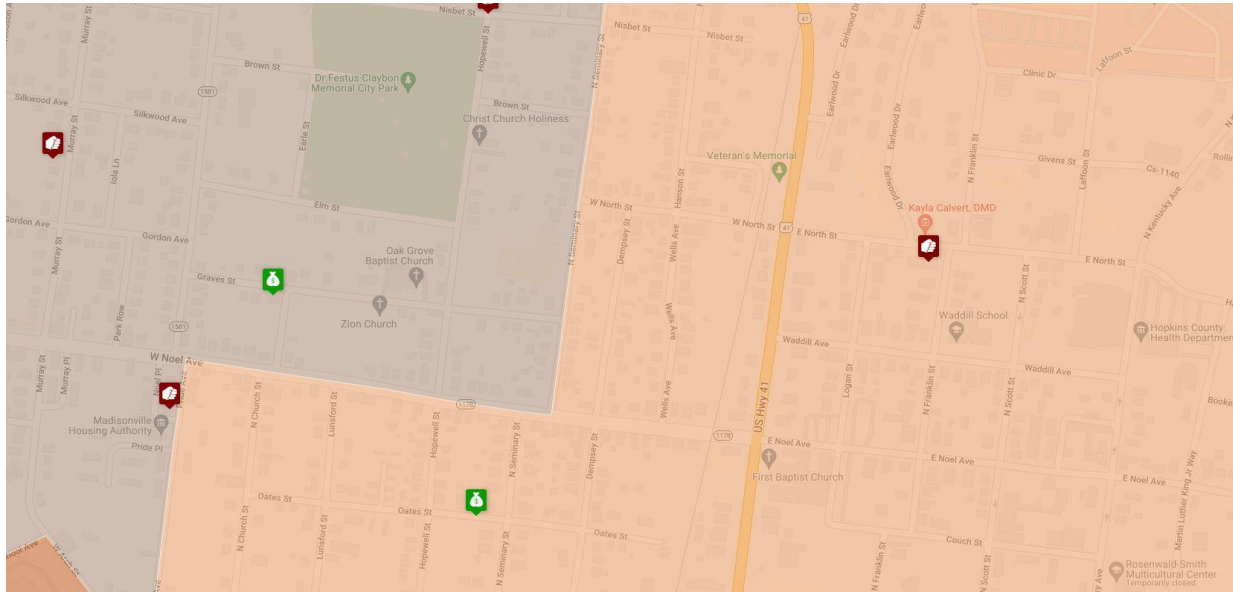

Part 1 Crimes Highest Density

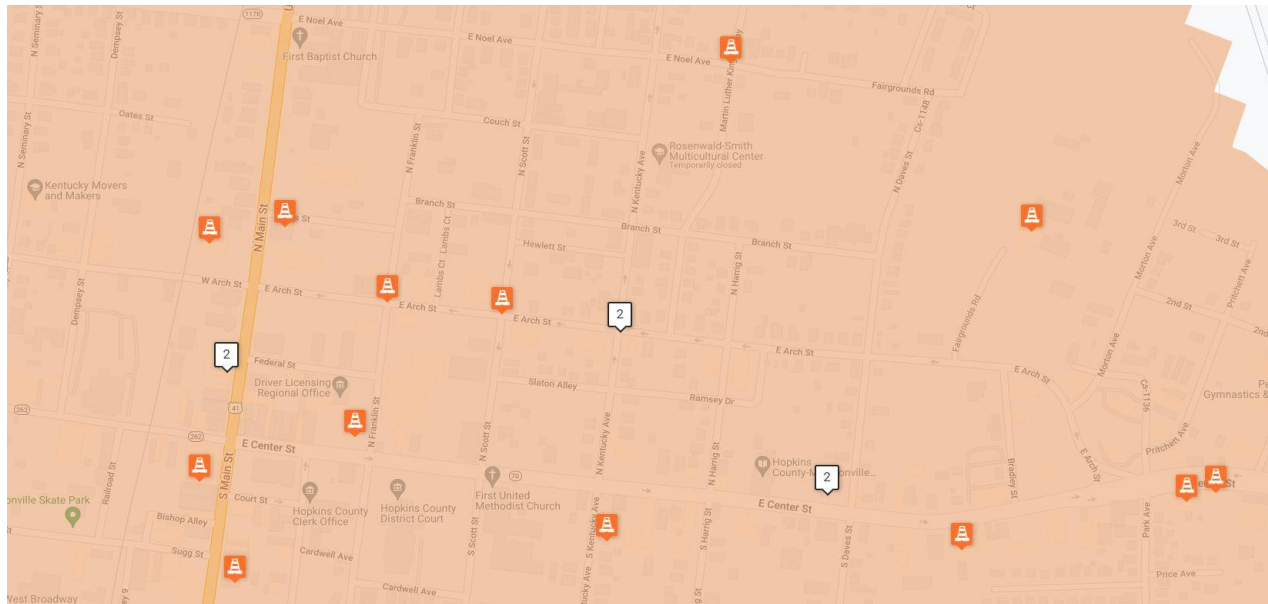

Traffic Accidents Highest Density





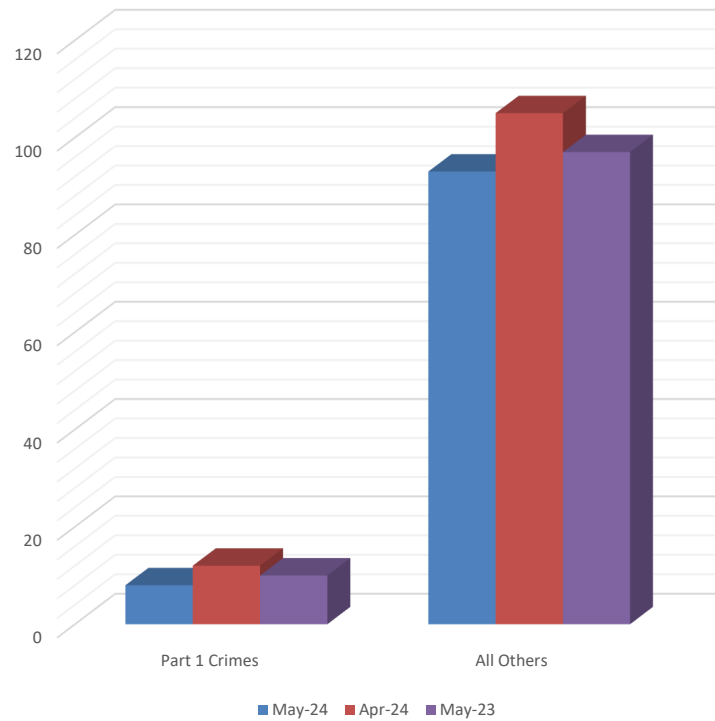

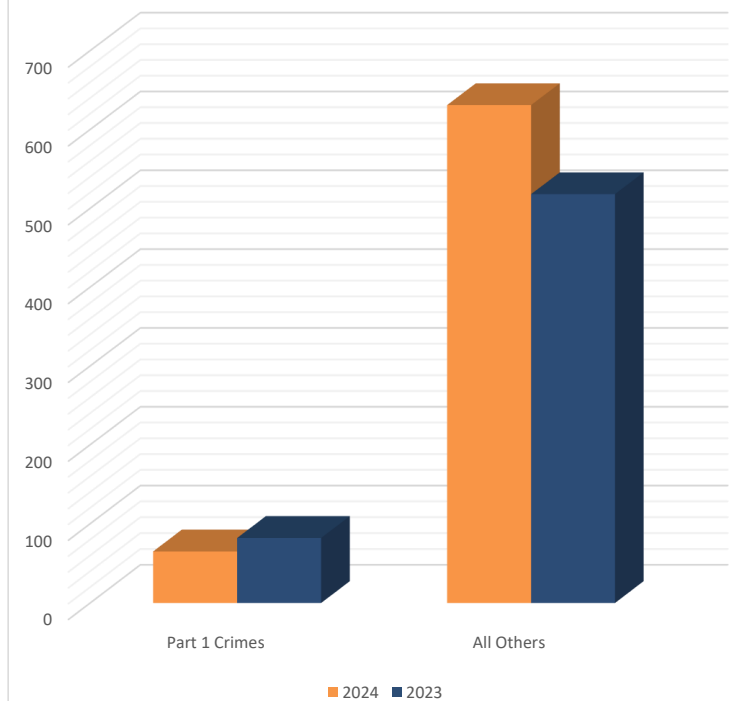

EXPLANATIONS

- (A) General Fund Revenue increased \$850,000 due to increases in tax revenue, interest income, drug forfeiture income, proceeds from Mahr Park Trust, sale of surplus property, logging income, donations and grant income.
- (B) General Fund Transfers & Other Sources decreased by \$340,000 due to the elimination of the transfer from the Sanitation Fund.
- (C) General Government Expenses decreased by \$200,000 due to transfers to police, fire, and health and public welfare, a decrease in capital outlay offset by increases in grant expenses and other capital outlay.
- (D) Police Expenses increased by \$350,000 due to increases in grant expenses, forfeiture expenses, and capital outlay which included the police training facility improvements.
- (E) Fire Expenses increased by \$50,000 due to increases in grant expenses and capital outlay which includes the fire training facility offset by a decrease in capital outlay.
- (F) Transportation Expenses decreased by \$380,000 due to decreases in road salt purchased, construction and other supplies, and capital outlay.
- (G) Cemetery Expenses increased by \$25,000 due to an increase in improvements to Forest Lawn and capital outlay.
- (H) Airport Expenses increased by \$300,000 due to increases in professional fees, tree removal, utilities, grant expenses and capital outlay.
- (I) Park Expenses increased by \$130,000 due to increases in agricultural supplies, repairs and upkeep and capital outlay.
- (J) Health & Public Welfare Revenues increased by \$139,500 due to increases in utilities, community support, capital outlay and grant assistance expenses.
- (K) ABC Fund Revenues increased by \$60,000 due to increases in fees collected and interest income.
- (L) ABC Fund Expenses increased by \$60,000 due to an increase in capital outlay.
- (M) Coal Severance Fund Revenues increased by \$78,500 due to increases in coal severance taxes received and interest income.
- (N) Coal Severance Fund Transfers to Other Funds increased by \$19,600 due to an increase in the transfer to the Municipal Aid Fund.
- (O) Municipal Aid Fund Revenues increased by \$58,800 due to increases in road aid discretionary funds received and interest income.

- (P) Municipal Aid Fund Transfers & Other Sources increased by \$19,600 due to an increase in the transfer from the Coal Severance Fund.
- (Q) Municipal Aid Fund Expenses increased by \$25,000 due to an increase in street paving.
- (R) Opioid Settlement Revenues increased by \$90,000 due to additional settlement income and interest income.
- (S) Opioid Settlement Expenses increased by \$10,000 due to an increase in capital outlay.
- (T) Restaurant Tax Revenues increased by \$85,000 due to an increase in interest income.
- (U) Restaurant Tax Events and Capital Projects increased by \$135,000 due to an increase in event expenses. Fourth Fest will all be held in June this fiscal year.
- (V) Sports Complex Expenses increased by \$320,000 due to increases in utilities, furnishings and capital outlay.
- (W) Health Insurance Fund Revenues increased by \$144,320 due to increases in employee deductions, interest income, and stop loss reimbursement from our insurance company.
- (X) Health Insurance Fund Expenses increased by \$158,500 due to increases in stop loss claims, clinic fees, prescription claims and health fair expenses.
- (Y) Water and Sewer Fund Revenues decreased by \$3,950,000 due to a decrease in bond and grant income.
- (Z) Water and Sewer Fund Expenses decreased in Wastewater Collections by \$4,335,000 due to a decrease in capital outlay.
- (AA) Water and Sewer Fund Expenses increased in Wastewater Treatment by \$500,000 due to increases in utilities, sludge hauling, health insurance expense, and capital outlay which includes ARPA expenses.
- (BB) Sanitation Fund Revenues increased by \$100,000 due to an increase in public access income.
- (CC) Sanitation Fund Expenses increased by \$443,970 due to increases in maintenance and repairs, hauling fees, equipment parts, tipping fees and capital outlay.
- (DD) Sanitation Transfer to Other Funds decreased by \$340,000 due to the elimination of the transfer to the General Fund.
