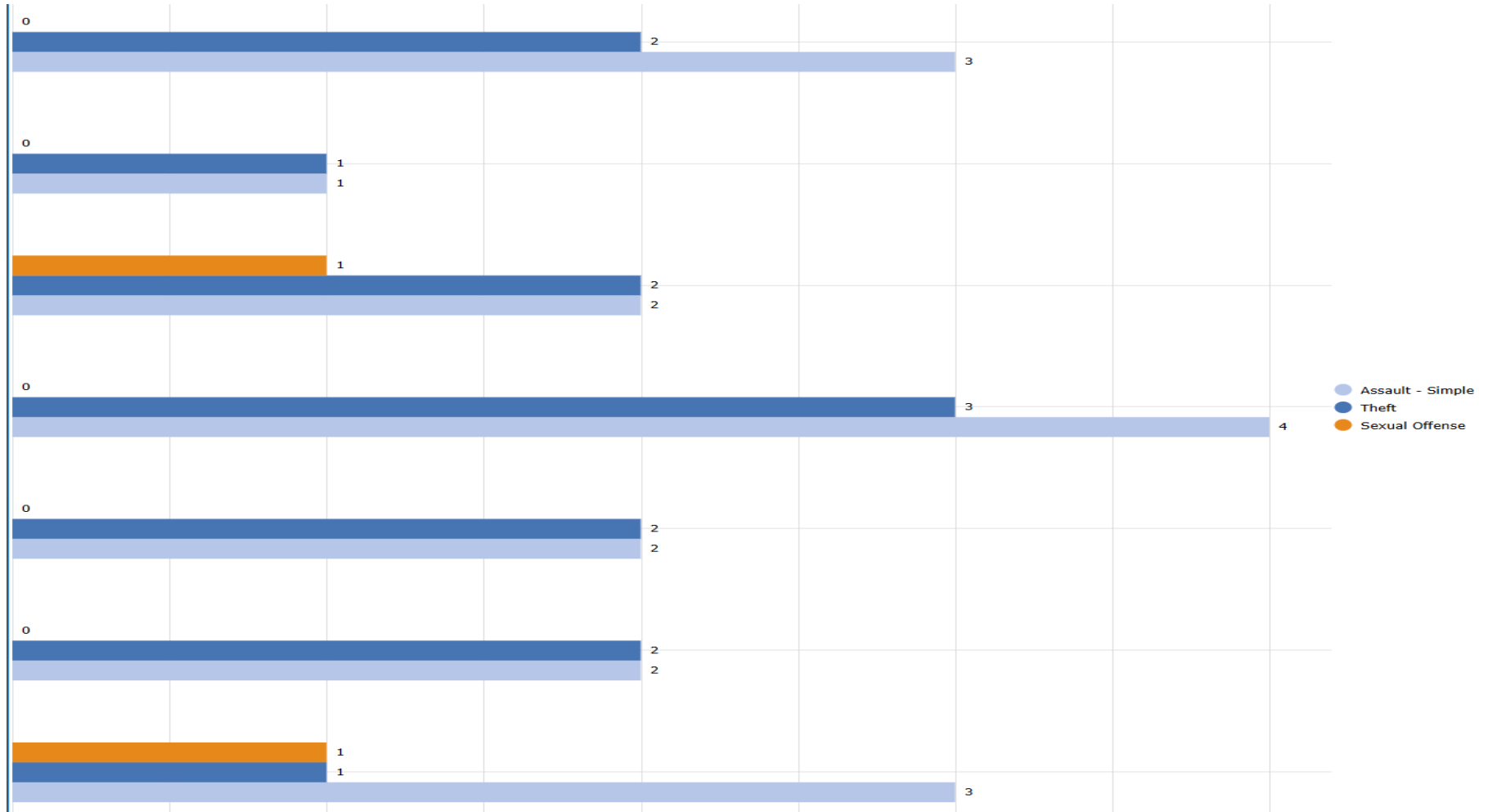

Part 1 Crimes by Day of Week

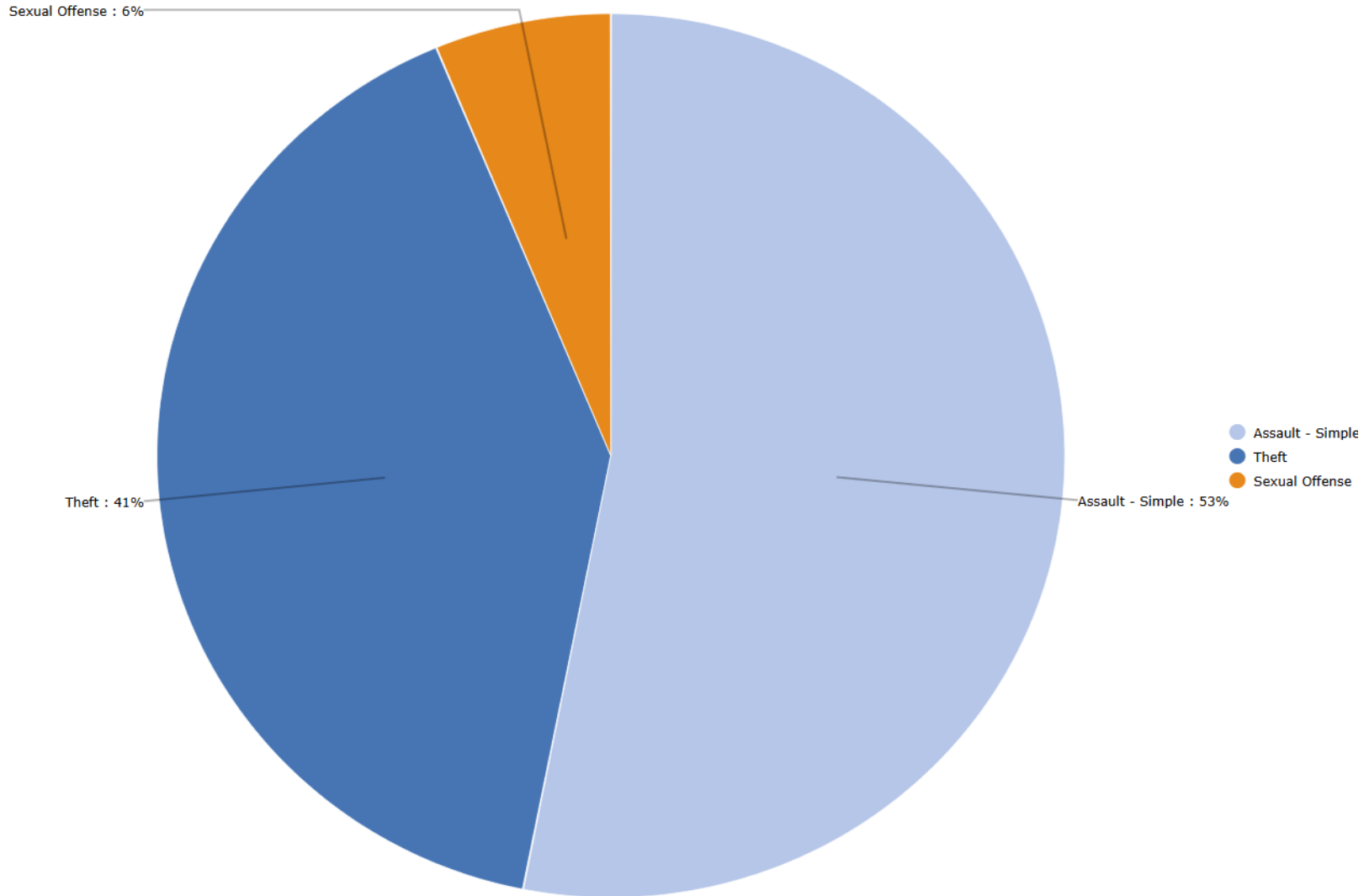

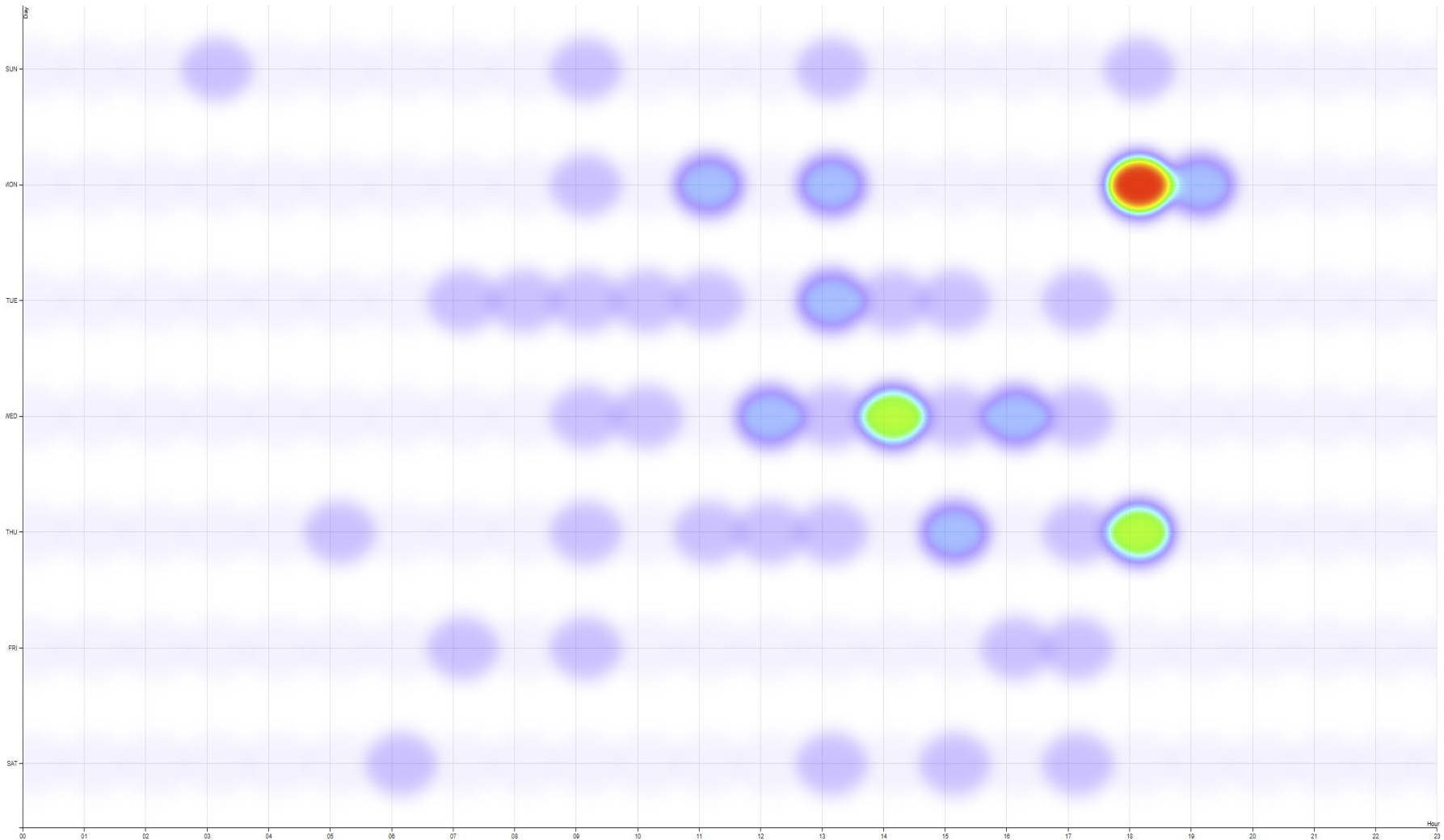

Traffic Accident Highest Times



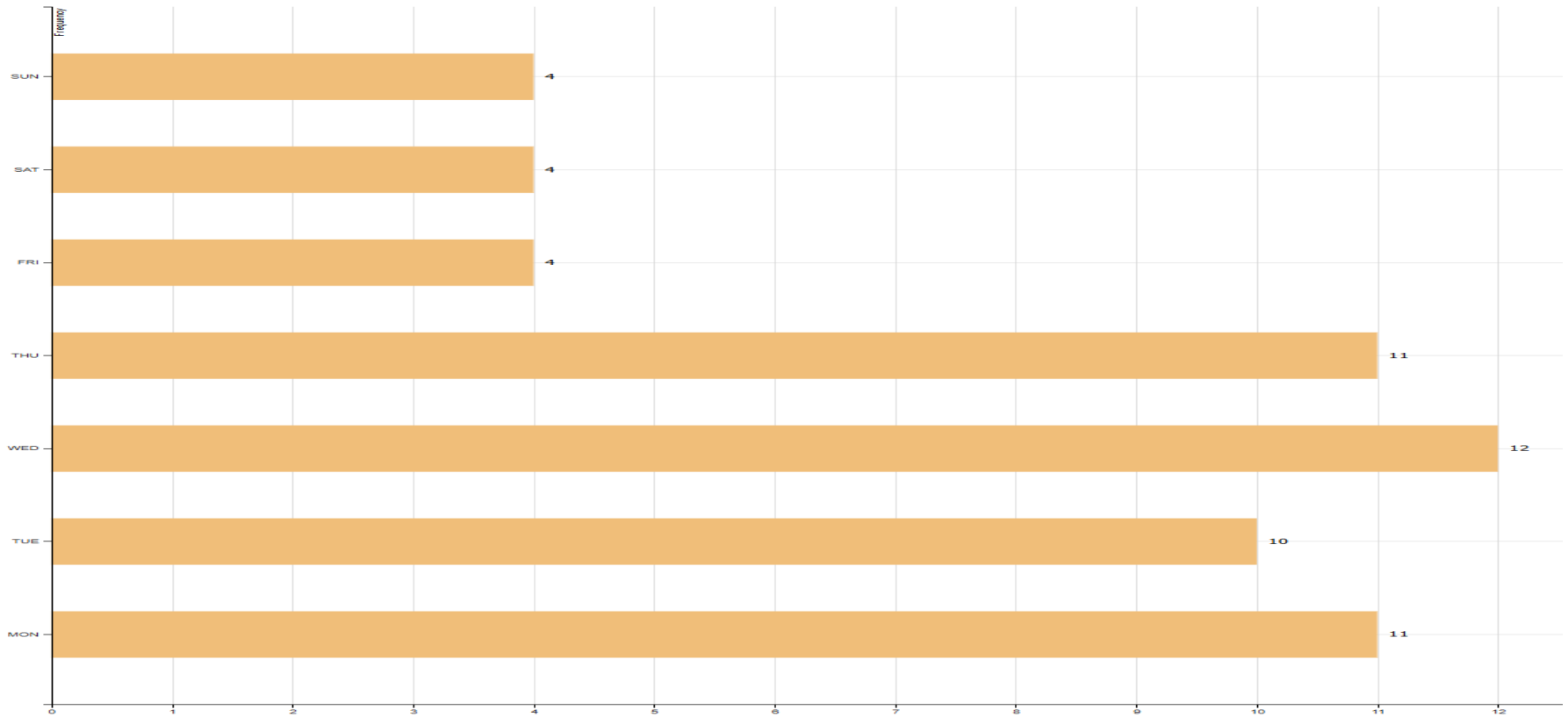

Traffic Accidents by Day of Week

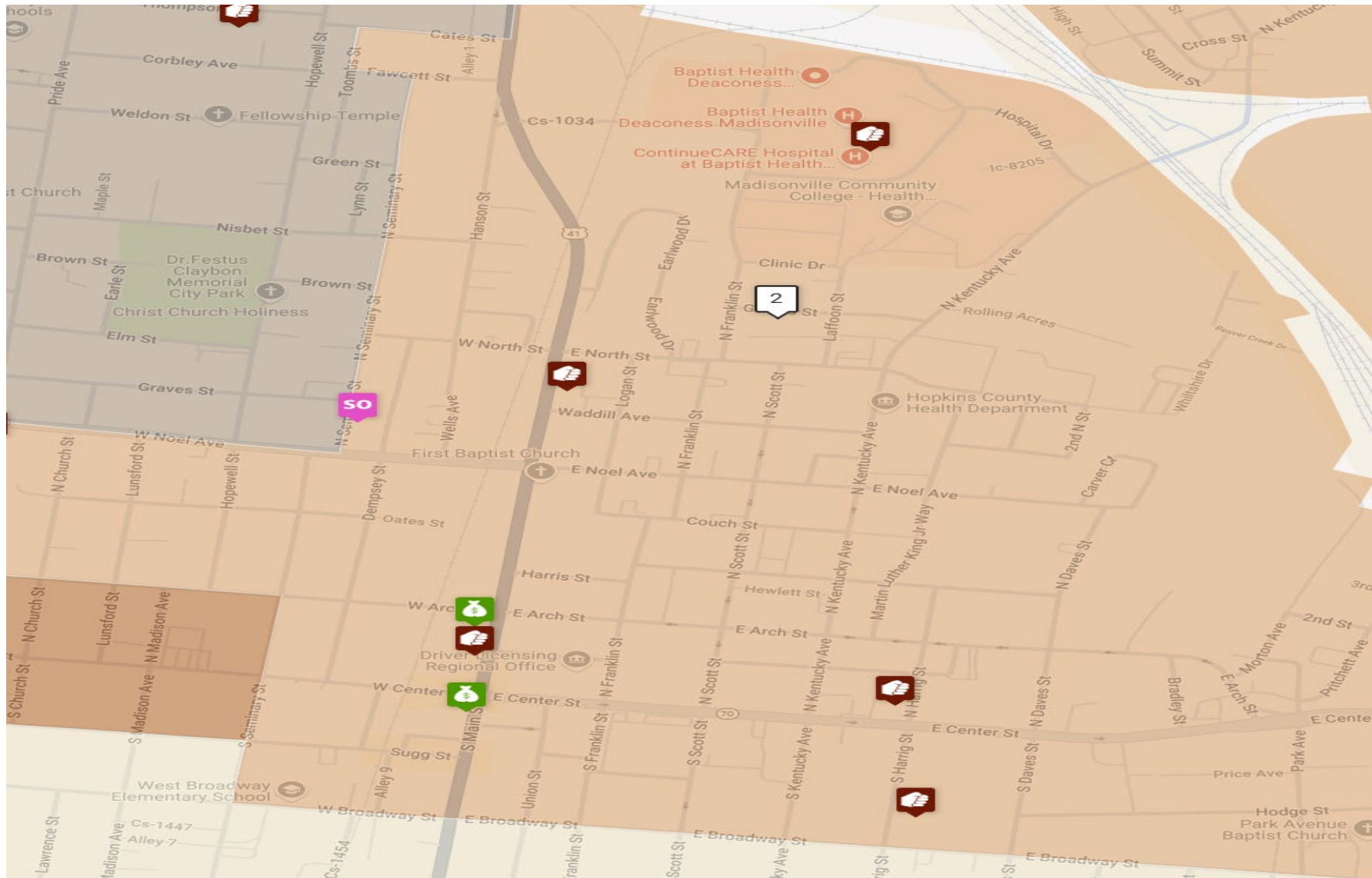

## Part 1 Crimes Highest Density

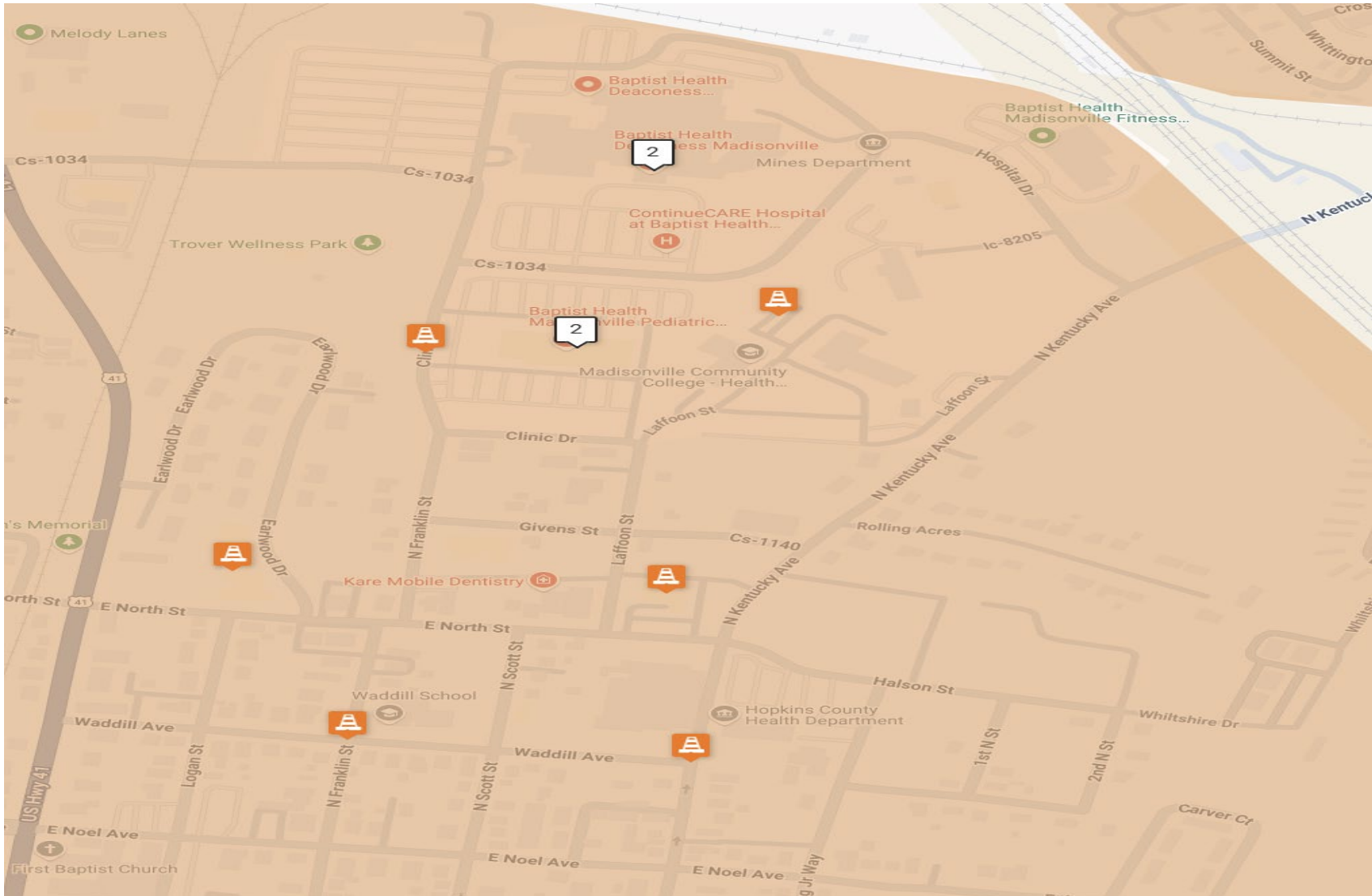

Traffic Accidents Highest Density





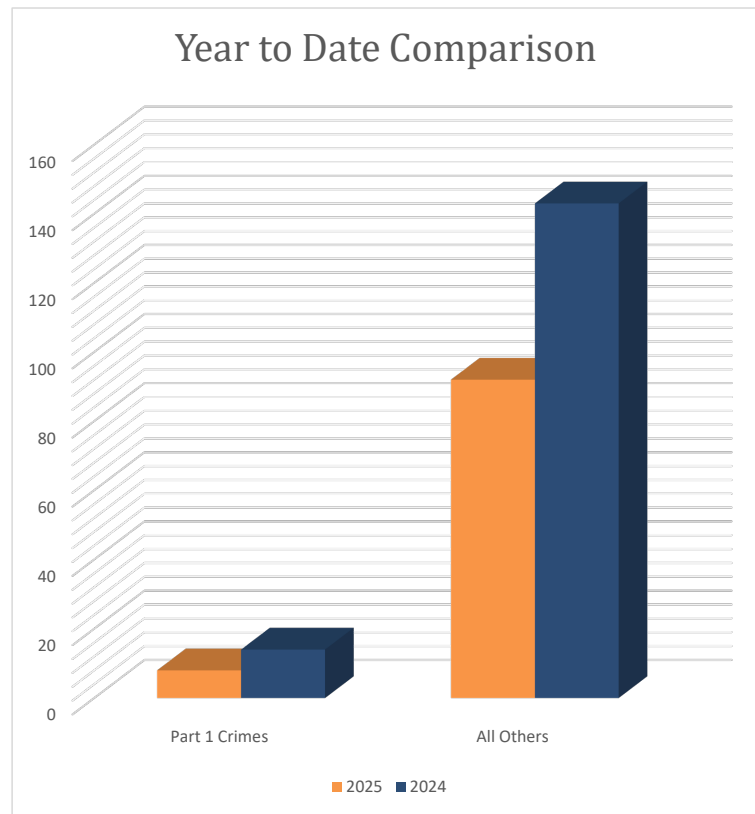
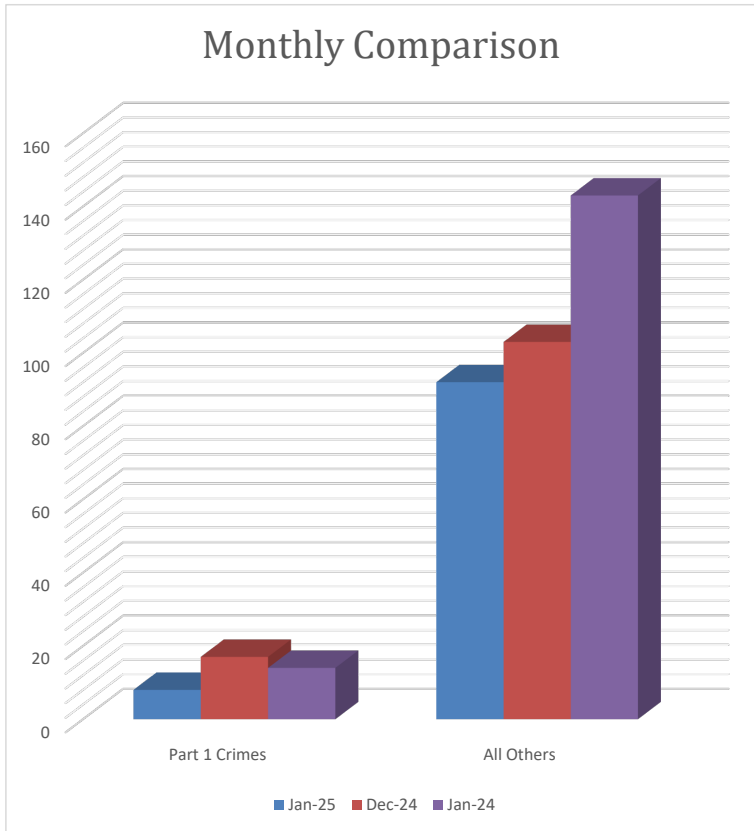
